This training will cover the material typically covered in both the webinar and the on-site session.

Every year, local agencies must collect Pavement Surface Evaluation and Rating (PASER) data on at least 50 percent of their paved federal-aid-eligible roads, and then submit the data to the Transportation Asset Management Council (TAMC). Agencies can also apply to the TAMC for grants to fund the data collection of paved non-federal-aid roads if they are trained.

The Center for Technology & Training (CTT) will be conducting a final rater training session on behalf of the TAMC in 2017. Raters who plan to evaluate federalaid-eligible roads in 2017 must have attended one of the PASER Training sessions.
