### 2020 Wait Road and North Centreville Road

Highly populated street
Wait Road was 20 ft wide
North Centreville 22 ft wide
Length of 0.7 Miles
ADT Wait = 2,166
ADT North Centreville 3,037





#### 2020 Wait Road and North Centreville Road

Full Reconstruction

Total Cost = \$424,146

Ted F Grant received for \$252,000

Total MTF = \$172,146

4' paved shoulders each side

 $8^{\prime}$  / 30  $^{\prime}$  or 26.67% of the project was non motorized

\$113,105 MTF Spent on Non Motorized

ADT = 3,061



















# Complications
