Field Manager needs replacing!



Field Manager 'sunsetting' in 2-ish years

- InfoTech/MDOT won't support Field Manager.
- No local jobs in AASHTOWare.

Solution = Road Conductor®

- Web-based app by Michigan Tech.
- Phase I: \$399,600 MTF.
- Phase II: Materials & Mobile Application.
- Phase II FY23 supplemental (Develop & Training)



Road Conductor® subscriptions



Subscriptions managed by County Road Association

- Agency (county, city, consultant) buys subscription/user.
- Annual renewal.
- Cost, early subscription time TBA.
- Steering committee guides admin, future dev.
- Subscriptions fund maint., R&D.

Road Conductor® timeline

Account Control and Core Functionality:

• Aug 2023 - Dec 2023

Functionality Enhancements:

• Oct 2023 - June 2025

User testing:

• Beginning mid-2024

Subscriptions sold:


• Late 2024

• Spring 2025 - Spring 2026


Mobile app:

FY 2025 MDOT Federal Aid Buyout Project





"On pause" eff. 12/11/2023

- Due to increased federal aid, bonding program, trunkline work in SE MI.
- MDOT must match its 75% share of federal aid.
- Huge disappointment to locals!
- FY2026 = "maybe"




A word on State "D"



Transportation Economic Dev. Fund – Category D

- **NEW!** Now a "cash out" direct grant program.
- To improve all-season road network.
- Often used as STP Rural 20% match.
- Use in 3 years; must report.
- On all-season network.

This was a CRA Legislative Priority!



Michigan Wetland Board


• Approximately 110 acres of mitigation credits available statewide



- Currently, 13 ecoregions have some bank credits available
- Goal: 10-acre bank site in all 31 ecoregions
- Partnering with MDOT, MMWA, and private banks
- Focus of our program-create more banks!

Local Disaster Relief Program/Fund

To assist w/disaster recovery on roads, bridges, other infrastructure

- Natural disasters or "other emergencies" that "affect transportation infrastructure."
- 2 bills ready for re-introduction.
- **NEW!** \$5M in FY 2024 budget.

This was a CRA Legislative Priority!

The Monarchs are coming!



Monarch endangered by fall 2024?

• Red tape for ROW projects!

Q: Any way to mitigate?

A: Candidate Conservation
Agreements with Assurances (CCAA)

- Enacted before T/E status.
- Adopt 5% of ROW to enroll 95%.
- Routine const./maint. covered.
- CRA apply for all. (<\$600/rural county)



ISPs working in the ROW





\$1.4B Broadband Equity Access & Deployment

(BEAD) coming to MI ROW.

Adopt definitions from CRA:

- Define project size: road corridor, other practical limit.
- Define routine work items under an annual permit.
- Establish wireless fees by Board.
- Educate early to avoid conflict!

BEAD checklist



Adopt CRA's permit fee schedule

- In CRA Tool Crib.
- Law enables +10% every 5 years.

Project only fiber, use CRA 100:

Use cable and fiber guidelines.

Project some wireless, use CRA 100 WP:

• Use wireless guidelines, fee schedule.





Permitting costs



Bottom line: Document all agency costs including:

- Plan reviews;
- Applicant meetings;
- Field visits;
- Project inspections;

- "Stop work" order costs;
- Additional fees to reimburse costs prior to restarting work.
- Additional bond if "stop work" issued.

CRA Rubber Modified Asphalt STIC Proposal



- Strategic Transportation Innovation Council- FHWA, MDOT, CRA, MML & Industry
- CRA Proposal Application Submitted 1-26-24
- Goal: develop local agency asphalt overlay & chip seal specifications
- Meta analysis of local road agency & other states recent successful projects
- Partners: EGLE, MTU, Bay CRC & CRA Engineering Innovation Subcommittee
- STIC Federal Grant Request \$125,000 & EGLE Matching funds \$25,000
- Schedule: Grant Award Anticipated in FY 24, Completion FY 26

CRA 2023 Investment Plan



- CRA Board Approved 2-5-24
- Goals: 90% (52%) Good-Fair FA Eligible Roads; 60% (46%) on non-FA Roads
- \$2.4 billion shortfall in County Road Agency to meet goals (^\$500 mil)
- Limited Non-FA Pavement Conditions Ratings Required Projections
