Information Technology Technician Intern

Information technology technicians prepare and maintain the hardware used by CTT employees. They construct computer systems for new employees and any employee who requires upgrades to their systems. Additionally, they maintain these machines and ensure they get all software updates and nightly backups.

Key responsibilities:

- Build new computers
- Troubleshoot hardware and software issues
- Maintain server and computer backups
- Execute asset management plan
- Update computer documentation

Additional responsibilities:

- Help others become familiar with new software or systems such as LastPass
- Set up employee workstations and desks
- Purchase replacement parts or additional hardware



All positions are paid. Year-round positions open with a minimum of 10 hours/week during the academic year and up to 40 hours/week during the summer.
