





Priority of Service

Priority of service is given to:

- Veterans
- Eligible spouses of veterans
- Low income individuals
- Basic skills deficient
- Underemployed/Unemployed







Work Registration for Unemployment

- When applying for Unemployment you will be required to "Register for Work"
- You will need to create an account on Pure Michigan Talent Connect
 - mitalent.org
- You will then need to come in-person or make a virtual appointment with Michigan Works for staff to verify your registration prior to your first call to MARVIN





What is Trade Adjustment Assistance?

Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA):

- Provides assistance to workers who lose their jobs as a result of foreign trade (increase in imports, shift in production or acquisition of services or articles from another country).
- The intent is to help laid off workers return to work as quickly as possible at a comparable wage.
